*Bereavement Dinner Ministry* – Becky Jozsa

- On going ministry to aid grieving families by providing a funeral luncheon for our parishioners and their extended families.
- Approximately 70 Funeral Luncheons served this year
- Current members of this ministry – 20
- New members this year – 1
- Need help with dishwashing, especially men who can lift the heavy trays in to and out of the dishwasher.

*Habitat for Humanity* – Dick DuCharme

- Genesee County Habitat for Humanity is a non-denominational Christian ministry whose mission is building houses and communities in partnership with God's people in need. Davison Church Covenant Habitat for Humanity Group built one house to accommodate a family with a handicapped child in a wheel chair.
- Currently not meeting as a group although leadership is on the lookout for land. It is difficult to find affordable land to build on in the Davison Area. Individuals interested in current builds are encouraged to become a part of a habit build in Flint.

*HUP – Helping Unemployed Persons* – Marji Theodoroff

- St. John partnered with St. Andrews Presbyterian, Davison Free Methodist and St. Francis Xavier to start this service for the unemployed. HUP's mission is to support individuals in a faith based setting as they deal with their unemployment and look for jobs.
- 115 people have used HUP Access Point (located in the Church Hall) to help them register with the Michigan Talent bank, create and submit resumes, and look for employment on the Internet. Trained volunteers assist them, and if needed, direct referrals for human services.
- Current members of this ministry – 9
- New members this year – 5
- Financial support for office supplies and Internet service is an ongoing need and with the addition of new members this ministry could reach out to more people in need.

*Sick/Homebound/Elderly* – Judy Neuharth

- On going ministry that takes the Eucharist weekly to persons who are unable to come to church for a period of time.
- Current members of this ministry – 10
- New members this year – 1
- With the addition of new members this ministry could reach out to more people in need.

*Transportation* – Judy Hogg

- Share your ride with persons who need transportation to and from church on Sundays and holydays.
- Number of persons transported to church each Sunday – 9
- Current members of this ministry – 4
- New members are needed to meet the unfilled requests for rides, especially for a person living west of Belsay Rd and one North of Richfield Rd.
